

## **LYNGBY TENNIS CLUB SEEKS A TEAM-ORIENTED AND PASSIONATE ELITE COACH WITH INTEGRITY AND PROFESSIONALISM**

Lyngby Tennis Club (LTK) is looking for a competent and skilled elite coach who will be in charge of training and developing the club's best players on both senior and junior level in close teamwork with the rest of the coaching staff.

LTK is an ambitious and well renowned tennis club in Denmark with about 800 passionate members. The club is situated in an attractive area, just 10 km north of Copenhagen.

The club has a long history as one of Denmark's leading elite clubs and several current senior and junior national team players, who represent the club and the country internationally, have their daily training in the club. LTK senior teams are placed in the highest division in Danish tennis. We also have veterans competing at the national and international level.

LTK's ambition is to strengthen our elite group and together with the rest of the coaching team you will have an important role in doing so. We value the very high quality of training given to all members and this also to ensure we keep developing and attracting junior and senior talents.

### **Key responsibilities:**

Your primary area of responsibility will be the training our junior and senior elite players. In addition to the daily training, you will be coaching team matches and regularly attend individual tournaments.

All member groups are important in LTK and therefore you must also to a limited extent contribute to the training of the club's other member groups. This can e.g. be member clinics or camps.

You will be responsible for one of the club's elite division teams and make all arrangements with players.

### **Job requirements:**

Several years of experience in training players at the highest level, while continuously making sure to stay up to date with relevant education.

Good at coaching and generally relating to players in a positive and constructive way.

For the junior players, to have the ability to create a good relationship with the parents through dialogues and meetings when necessary.

In addition to being highly qualified in the field of tennis we emphasize that you are a distinct team player who is naturally part of a constructive collaboration with the rest of the coaching team in the club. As part of the coaching team you contribute positively to the social environment of the club so that LTK appears as an attractive place to play tennis.

### **What we can offer you:**

We know that moving to DK can be challenging and we will help you with as much paperwork as we can, help finding accommodation, etc.

A full time job approx. 37 hours/week in a club environment with good facilities consisting of 13 outdoor courts and 4 indoor courts.

Monthly salary of 4.800 Euros plus holiday pay during the 5 weeks of vacation (which is normal for a full-time position in DK).

A great team consisting of 4 permanent coaches and several hourly coaches who look forward to getting you on board. We put great effort into working together and helping each other – tennis is an individual sport, but we are a team!

Approximately 25 hours on court pr. week. The rest of your working time is administration and these tasks will mostly be managing team matches, preparing for training or events and communicating with players.

You can expect a few weeks of traveling to ITF, TE or other tournaments. All travel expenses will be paid by the club.
